BYLAW NO. B279/15 SPEED LIMIT BYLAW

BEING A BYLAW OF NORTHERN SUNRISE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTROLLING THE SPEED LIMITS ON PORTIONS OF TOWNSHIP ROAD 810, TOWNSHIP ROAD 820, TOWNSHIP ROAD 822, RANGE ROAD 194 AND RANGE ROAD 210

WHEREAS the *Traffic Safety Act*, R.S.A. 1999, provides for regulation of the speed of highway traffic thereof, and;

AND WHEREAS Section 7 (a) of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, provides that Council may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Northern Sunrise County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That signs be posted on Township Road 810 at Highway 2 on the West to a point 12 km to the East setting the speed limit at 100 km per hour;
2. That signs be posted on Township Road 820 at Highway 2 on the West to Range Road 194 on the East setting the speed limit at 100 km per hour;
3. That signs be posted on Range Road 194 at Township Road 820 on the South to Township road 822 on the North setting the speed limit at 100 km per hour;
4. That signs be posted on Township Road 822 at Range Road 194 on the West to a point 24.2 km to the East setting the speed limit at 100 km per hour;
5. That signs be posted on Range Road 210 at Highway 688 on the South to Township Road 840 on the North setting the speed limit at 100 km per hour.

Bylaw No. B279/15 will come into effect on the date it is signed.

Read a first time in Council this 26 day of May, 2015.

Read a second time in Council this 26 day of May, 2015.

Public Hearing held the 23 day of June, 2015.

Read a third and final time in Council this 23 day of June, 2015.
