



County Secures Long-Term Gravel Supply

Northern Sunrise County is pleased to announce the acquisition of a 400-year supply of gravel.

“A long-term gravel supply is critical to the planning and maintenance of our transportation network,” Reeve Garrett Tomlinson said. “With this acquisition, residents can be assured that the County is planning responsibly for the future.”

The resource is located in the Marie Reine area and will serve as a strategic resource for the County’s South-West infrastructure. The purchase provides for the preservation of a historically significant site. The area will continue to be referred to as Murphy’s Flats.

The County will immediately initiate the planning process necessary for gravel extraction; however, development is not expected to commence until 2020.
