

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

May 9, 2017 Council Meeting

Bylaws

- ⇒ Council has given first and second reading to Bylaw B310/17 Prohibited Noxious Weed as presented to designate Glyphosate Tolerant or Resistant Alfalfa as a prohibited noxious weed in the County. Administration will send the bylaw to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry for approval before giving third reading.
- ⇒ Council passed Bylaw B309/17 for the purpose of redistricting approximately 12.52 acres within NE-9-85-20-W5M from Rural Industrial District (RM) to Agricultural District (A) in the Three Creeks area.
- ⇒ Council gave first reading to Bylaw B311/17 Intermunicipal Development Plan between the Village of Nampa and Northern Sunrise County. A Public Hearing with the Village of Nampa has been scheduled for June 13, 2017 at 7:00 pm at the Northern Sunrise County Council Chambers. Council has requested Administration to invite representatives from Canadian Natural Resources Ltd. to attend a future Council meeting and provide an update on their Peace River operations.

Council directed Administration to send correspondence to Premier Rachel Notley requesting a list of community leaders that were notified regarding the Request for Proposal for Air Ambulance services.

Council has directed Administration to provide two loads of gravel placed behind the Nampa Regional Civic Centre building.

- ⇒ Council approved the updated Terms of Reference for the Economic-Tourism and Development Committee.
- ⇒ Council approved the Northern Sunrise County/Village of Nampa, Nampa & District Museum Operations Sustainability Committee Terms

of Reference as presented and that Administration forward the Terms of Reference to the Village of Nampa for review.

Council has appointed the following individuals as Weed and Pest Inspectors for the period of their 2017 employment with Northern Sunrise County: Sebastien Dutrisac, Stephanie Soucy, Toni Dolhan, Christina Thiessen, Jason Gall, Nicholas Kenny, Madison Brent, Megan Whitmore, and Michael Harris.

Donations and Sponsorships:

- ⇒ \$500 to Vision Credit Union to sponsor the putting contest at the upcoming Vision Credit Union Annual Charity Golf Tournament on June 17, 2017.
- ⇒ Council approved the request for 100 tonnes of gravel for La Societe Des Compagnons Ltee for driveway repairs in the hamlet of St. Isidore.
- ⇒ Council has authorized the donation of \$600 to each community group organizing a Seniors' Week event.
- ⇒ Council has donated \$3,000 to the Peace River Community Soup Kitchen for their operations.

Council has directed Administration to send a letter indicating Council's support to the AFPA regarding the softwood lumber dispute.

Council directed Administration to schedule a conference call meeting with the Minister of Health on May 17 regarding the Peace River Medical Clinic, and to invite the Peace River Medical Clinic Planning Committee members.

Council directed Administration to advertise for a member-at-large to sit on the Economic-Tourism Development Committee.
