

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

June 27, 2017 Council Meeting

Bylaws

- ⇒ Council has passed Bylaw B311/17 Intermunicipal Development Plan between the Village of Nampa and Northern Sunrise County. The bylaw and the Intermunicipal Development Plan will be posted on the County's website.
- ⇒ Council has passed the amendments to Bylaw B190/11 Municipal Planning Commission Bylaw and Bylaw B253/14 Development Officer Bylaw which removes specific numbering of the Land Use Bylaw from these two bylaws. The bylaws will be posted on the County's website.
- ⇒ Council has passed Bylaw B313/17 for the purpose of redistricting 10 acres within SW-84-20-W5M from Agricultural District (A) to Country Residential District (CR).
- ⇒ Council gave first reading to Bylaw B315/17 for the purpose of redistricting four lots within SW-11-86-14-W5M; Plan 8121420; Block 10; Lots 91 & 92 and NE-10-86-14-W5M; Plan 8121430; Block 3; Lot 52 and Block 1; Lot 10 from Forestry District (F) to Little Buffalo District (LB). A Public Hearing for this bylaw has been scheduled for July 18, 2017 at 10:00 a.m.

Council directed Administration to send a letter to Canada Post with copies to the Federal Minister of Public Services and Procurement and MP Arnold Viersen stating that the County agrees with the recommendations of the Standing Committee on Government Operations and Estimates to maintain and protect the current moratorium list on rural post offices.

Council directed Administration to include a youth position for remuneration on the Economic Tourism Development Committee and include this position in the Committee's Terms of Reference.

- ⇒ Tony Kulbisky, Alberta representative with the Canadian Association of Municipal Administrators presented the Canadian Association of Municipal Administrators Environment Award for municipalities under 20,000 pop. to Northern Sunrise County for the solar project at the St. Isidore/Three Creeks Fire Hall.
- ⇒ Cam Sorenson and Chris Montgomery with the Canadian Association of Petroleum Producers provided Council with a presentation regarding the continuing challenges in the oil and gas sector.
