

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

July 18, 2017 Council Meeting

Bylaws & Policies

- ⇒ Council passed Bylaw B315/17 for the purpose of redistricting four lots within SW-11-86-14-W5M; Plan 8121420; Block 10; Lots 91 & 92 and NE-10-86-14-W5M; Plan 8121430; Block 3; Lot 52 and Block 1; Lot 10 from Forestry District (F) to Little Buffalo District (LB).
- ⇒ Council approved the amended Economic & Tourism Development Committee Terms of Reference to include a youth representative on the Committee.

Council has directed Administration to refer the report regarding the development of a day use area in Murphy's Flats to the County strategic planning session on November 21-22, 2017.

Council has appointed Reeve Tomlinson and Deputy Reeve Kolebaba as associate members on the Northwest Species at Risk Committee, with Councilor Duval as an alternate member.

Council allowed for the provision of an advance vote and incapacitated voting for the 2017 Municipal Election. Incapacitated Voting will take place on October 11, 2017. Advance Voting will take place on the following dates: October 12, 2017 from 1:30 p.m. – 8:00 p.m., October 13, 2017 from 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., and October 14, 2017 from 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. The advanced voting station will be at the County Administration Building. Additional information regarding the advance and incapacitated voting will be advertised closer to the dates.

Council has proclaimed September 24 – 30, 2017 as Development Officer's Week in the County.
