



POLICY 6.8 MAINTENANCE OF PRIVATE DRIVEWAYS

PURPOSE AND SCOPE:

To regulate the use of County equipment and personnel for service on private driveways.

POLICY:

1. SUMMER:

County equipment will not be used to maintain private driveways throughout the summer months except for work authorized by Council in accordance with the policy on "Installation and Maintenance of Culverts/Approaches".


2. WINTER:

- a) Snow plowing of private driveways will be done only by appointment, established by the County office at 9:00 a.m. weekday mornings.
- b) The service will be provided only if County employees are not required for public roads.
- c) Only driveways that have a County flag at the entrance will be plowed, with the exception of the following community halls which will not be charged for snowplowing and do not require a flag:
 - i) Mamowintowin Hall in Cadotte Lake
 - ii) McKinney Hall
 - iii) St. Isidore Cultural Centre
 - iv) Harmon Valley Hall
 - v) Reno Hall
 - vi) Marie Reine Hall
 - vii) Peace River Agricultural Fairgrounds
 - vii) All water key locks, sewer lift stations, and transfer stations


Community Halls will be given no special priority for snowplowing.

- d) Snow plowing of graveyard road approaches will be done as part of the regular grader beat.

- e) This policy does not guarantee, imply, or suggest that any of the driveways described in clause 2 (a) and (c) will be kept clear of snow, and the County will not be responsible for any action or inaction taken as a result of this policy.
- f) Flags may be purchased at the County Administration Building and will be issued only after a snowplowing agreement is completed in full, as per "Schedule A" (attached).
- g) Driveways must be plowed on a regular basis to prevent the accumulation of compact snow which the County snow removal equipment may not be able to remove.
- g) The truck operator has the right to refuse to plow any driveway, but upon doing so must provide a written explanation to the Director of Public Works stating the reasons for refusal.
- h) If the Director of Public Works and/or the Chief Administrative Officer are unable to resolve the problem, the matter shall be taken to Council for a decision.
